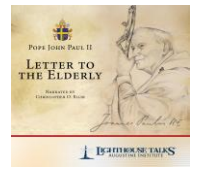
**World Day of Prayer for the Church in China**

2. Also during the winter months, we were able to update the associate's apartment (removal of the ancient carpet, painting of the walls, installation of the new floor) where Fr. Francesco resides in the rectory. We had number of parishioners involved in the process of restorations: Mr. Victor Puglia, Mr. Luigi D'Antonio, Mr. Dominic Trombetta and Mr. Gabriele Capone. I thank you very much for your time, dedication, hard work, donations and advice throughout this project.  
3. And finally my thanks to Mr. Ugo Pin for building a new credence table for the church that is located behind the presider's chair in the sanctuary and holds the vessels that are used at Mass. *Fr. Mariusz*
