

Our four-legged friends are family too!! Sandi Cowden's recipe for Doggy Cookies for your Dog


INGREDIENTS

- 3 cups flour 3 cups whole wheat flour 1 cup cornmeal
- 2 Tbsp salt

3 cups chicken broth
2 cups bulgur or cracked wheat
½ cup instant skim milk powder

DIRECTIONS

Mix all ingredients together with hands. Roll out onto floured pastry board to $\frac{1}{4}$ inch thick. Cut into shapes with cookie cutters. Place on ungreased cookie sheet and brush with milk. Bake at 300 F to 325 F for about 45 minutes. Turn off heat and leave cookies in oven until completely cool. Store in tins.
