
## **CONGRATULATIONS!**





## WEEKLY RECIPE - PAULA BODDEN'S BRAISED BEEF WITH PASTA

### **Ingredients:**

- 2 Tbsp vegetable oil
- 2 lbs rump roast
- 2 onions, chopped
- 4 cloves garlic, crushed
- 2 stalks celery, chopped
- 1 large carrot, chopped
- 1 cup beef broth
- 28 oz can plum tomatoes
- 1/2 cup dry red wine

- 3 Tbsp tomato paste
- Pinch salt, pepper, thyme
- 1/4 cup fresh parsley
- 1 lb penne pasta

### **Directions:**

Heat oil on medium high in large roasting pan and brown roast on all sides. Remove from pan. Reduced heat to medium. Add onions, garlic, celery and carrot. Cook, stirring occasionally, for 10 minutes, or until softened. Remove to a bowl.

Return roast to pan, add beef broth and wine. Bring to a boil. Cover and cook in preheated 350°F oven for 1 hour. Remove roast pan from oven and place roast on cutting board. Slice meat into 1/4 inch thick slices. Return to roast pan. Add onion mixture, tomatoes, tomato paste and spices. Put back in oven, covered, for 1-1/2 to 2 hours until meat falls apart. Remove meat from sauce. Shred meat by pulling slices into strips. Return to sauce. Add parsley. Meanwhile, cook penne. Drain, put on a large platter and cover with meat sauce.
