WEEKLY RECIPE

MIRANDA MURACA'S PEANUT BUTTER BALLS

Ingredients:

- 4 cups peanut butter
- 4 cups icing sugar
- 8 Tbsp softened butter
- 6 cups Rice Krispies
- 300 g pkg semi-sweet chocolate chips
- 2(300 g) pkg butterscotch chips

Directions:


Stir together first four ingredients in a large bowl. Put in freezer for 1 hour for easier handling later.
