





# HOW TO SPIRITUALLY ARMOR YOUR CHILDREN BEFORE SCHOOL

Each morning, as you pack lunches, check backpacks, and hustle to get out the door, you prepare your children for the physical challenges of the day. But how often do you stop to prepare them for the spiritual battles they will face at school?

As a Catholic parent, you must remember: your children are targets in a world that often opposes their innocence, faith, and purity. That's why it's crucial to send them out not just with shoes and books—but with the ARMOR OF GOD.



Here's how to **spiritually armor** your children before school:

#### 1. BEGIN WITH THE SIGN OF THE CROSS

The simplest and most powerful way to begin is: "In the Equip them with spiritual weapons: A small crucifix or name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit." This ancient gesture calls upon the Holy Trinity and reminds your child that they are marked by Christ and never alone.

#### 2. Pray with Them—Out Loud

Don't skip morning prayer. Even just a short, heartfelt prayer like: "Lord Jesus, walk with my child today. Keep them safe, pure, kind, and strong. Send Your angels to guard them, and may they always know You are near. Amen." Hearing your voice call on God's protection will anchor their day with spiritual confidence.

#### 3. Bless Them with Holy Water

Keep a small bottle of holy water by the door. Make the Tell them: "Be a light. Be kind. Be strong. Stand up for Sign of the Cross on their forehead as they leave, saying: "May the Precious Blood of Jesus cover you and protect you today." This is more than symbolic. It is a sacramental—a real way the Church allows grace to flow.

#### 4. GIVE THEM A SACRAMENTAL TO WEAR OR CARRY

Saint medal. A blessed rosary in their backpack. A scapular worn under their clothing. These items are not good luck charms. They are visible reminders of their identity in Christ and of the prayers surrounding them.

#### 5. TEACH THEM SHORT SPIRITUAL WEAPONS

Give your child a few phrases they can say during the day when afraid, tempted, or lonely:

"Jesus, I trust in You."

"Come, Holy Spirit."

"Saint Michael the Archangel, defend me."

These words are powerful. They invite divine help instantly.

#### 6. ENCOURAGE KINDNESS AND COURAGE

what's right, even if you're the only one." Plant the seed of Catholic virtue in their heart—and water it daily.

#### 7. Pray for Them Throughout the Day

While they're at school, continue to pray: "Mother Mary, wrap your mantle around my child. Keep them safe in body, mind, and soul." Remember: You're Not Sending Them Alone.

When your child walks into that school building, they're not alone. They carry the prayers of their family, the grace of the sacraments, and the power of God's presence. By spiritually armoring them each morning, you're doing something that no worldly preparation can replace. You're shaping their heart for heaven, even as they walk the halls of earth.
