

THINKFAST SOCIAL JUSTICE RETREAT DAY (GRADE 5 AND UP)

THINKfast is our parish's annual social justice event for youth, which aims to help students learn more about issues facing the world's poor and what we can do to make a difference from here in Canada.

To the Faithful of the Diocese of Hamilton

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

The season of Lent presents to us the privileged paths of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving, inviting us to strip away all that holds us back from a deeper relationship with the Lord Jesus Christ. Prayer connects us with the very Author of life, while fasting sharpens our attention to those things which truly nourish our spirit. Almsgiving, in turn, is an essential expression of our Lenten journey, allowing us to put our faith into action by serving the Lord through those whom He holds so dearly: the poor and the disadvantaged.

Giving to those in need not only helps to transform their lives—a worthy pursuit in itself—but it transforms our own hearts and lives as well. Serving Christ in His poor configures us more closely to the Lord and draws us nearer to the Kingdom He proclaimed during His public ministry. In *Dilexi te*, Pope Leo XIV's recent Apostolic Exhortation, our Holy Father reminds us: *"I am convinced that the preferential choice for the poor is a source of extraordinary renewal both for the Church and for society, if we can only set ourselves free of our self-centeredness and open our ears to their cry."*

On Sunday, March 22, 2026, the Fifth Sunday of Lent, our parishes will invite support for Development and Peace – Caritas Canada through the Solidarity Sunday Collection. This year's Share Lent campaign, *On Track for Justice*, is an important expression of solidarity with Catholics across Canada and with our brothers and sisters throughout the world who rely on these vital humanitarian initiatives. I am deeply grateful for your generous support in past years and for the many ways you continue to advance works of justice and compassion.

This collection takes place during the Jubilee Year of Saint Francis of Assisi, proclaimed by the Holy Father to mark 800 years since the saint's passing to eternal life. The life of Saint Francis bears enduring witness to the inseparable bond between Christ and the poor, reminding us that self-giving love for Christ bears abundant evangelical fruit in every generation. May his example inspire us to respond generously to those in need this Solidarity Sunday.

As we journey through Lent, let us recall the words of the prophet Micah and embrace anew what the Lord asks of us: *"to act justly, to love tenderly, and to walk humbly with your God"* (Micah 6:8). With gratitude and prayerful best wishes for a blessed and fruitful Lenten journey, I remain

A Helpful Guide for a Fruitful and Faithful Lent

Lent is a sacred season of grace — forty days given to us by the Church to return to the Lord with all our hearts. It is not merely about “giving something up,” but about drawing closer to Jesus Christ through prayer, repentance, sacrifice, and charity. When embraced intentionally, Lent becomes a powerful tool for spiritual renewal.

Below is a practical guide to help make this Lent prayerful, focused, and spiritually fruitful.

1. BEGIN WITH A CLEAR INTENTION

Before choosing what to “do” for Lent, ask:

- Where is God inviting me to grow?
- What habit most weakens my spiritual life?
- What practice would help me love God and others more?

Lent is most successful when it is specific and intentional. Rather than vague goals (“pray more”), choose concrete ones (“pray 10 minutes each morning with Scripture”).

2. DEEPEN YOUR PRAYER LIFE

Prayer is the foundation of Lent. Without it, fasting becomes dieting and almsgiving becomes philanthropy.

Consider:

- Daily Mass once a week in addition to Sunday
- Spending 10–15 minutes a day with Scripture (perhaps the daily Gospel)
- Praying the Rosary regularly
- Making a weekly Holy Hour before the Blessed Sacrament
- Attending Stations of the Cross on Fridays

If your prayer life has been inconsistent, start small — consistency matters more than intensity.

3. EMBRACE MEANINGFUL FASTING

Fasting trains the heart in discipline and reminds us that God alone satisfies.

The Church calls us to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday and to abstain from meat on Fridays during Lent. Beyond this, consider:

- Fasting from social media
- Reducing screen time
- Giving up unnecessary snacking
- Fasting from complaining or negative speech

True fasting should create space — space for prayer, for silence, for charity.

4. PRACTICE GENEROUS ALMSGIVING

Almsgiving is not only financial. It is any act of self-giving love.

Ways to grow in charity:

- Support a local or international charity
- Visit or call someone who is lonely
- Volunteer within the parish
- Offer forgiveness where it is needed
- Perform hidden acts of kindness

Lent teaches us that love must be concrete.

5. GO TO CONFESSION

A successful Lent always includes the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Confession is not a sign of failure, but of courage and trust in God’s mercy.

Plan ahead. Mark a date on your calendar. Prepare with an examination of conscience. Allow the Lord to renew your heart.

6. SIMPLIFY AND CREATE SILENCE

Lent invites us to quiet the noise of our lives.

Consider:

- Turning off music in the car and driving in silence
- Putting the phone away during meals
- Creating a small prayer corner at home
- Reading a spiritual book instead of scrolling

Silence helps us hear the voice of God more clearly.

7. KEEP YOUR EYES ON EASTER

Lent is not meant to leave us discouraged. It leads to joy. Every sacrifice, every prayer, every hidden act of love prepares our hearts for the Resurrection.

If you falter, begin again. The Lord is patient. The goal of Lent is not perfection, but conversion.

A SIMPLE LENTEN PLAN

To make this practical, choose:

- One prayer commitment
- One fasting discipline
- One act of charity
- One date for Confession

Write them down. Keep them visible. Revisit them weekly.

May this Lent be a time of renewal for our parish family — a season where we return to the Lord with deeper faith, stronger discipline, and greater love. If we enter Lent with sincerity, Easter will not simply be a celebration on the calendar, but a resurrection within our hearts.

Let us walk this journey together.

The Way of the Cross, also known as the Stations of the Cross, are a way to pray and meditate on Christ's sacrifice for us. It is divided into fourteen stations from the time He was condemned to His burial.

7 BENEFITS OF PRAYING THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS

1. It gives us a way to make a spiritual pilgrimage.
2. We can gain a plenary indulgence to shorten our time in Purgatory.
3. Praying the Stations of the Cross helps inspire deep prayer.
4. We can look at suffering from a different perspective.
5. Praying this devotion helps us grow in our love for God.
6. Praying the stations helps us to become holy.
7. We learn to hope in the promise of salvation.
